is a high-impact, fixed income product that supports a diversified portfolio of nonprofits, microfinance institutions, social enterprises, and loan funds that benefit underserved communities in the U.S. and around the world. Investors earn a fixed financial return, generate measurable social returns, and benefit from Calvert Foundation's 20-year track record of solid portfolio performance.

HIGHLIGHTS

MINIMUM INVESTMENT	\$20 online; \$1,000 directly or through brokerage accounts
FINANCIAL RETURN	0–4% at terms of 1–15 years
SOCIAL RETURN	Measured annually by sector-specific indicators, and reported to investors through Calvert Foundation's social impact report and quarterly updates.
CONVENIENCE	Invest through brokerage accounts, directly through Calvert Foundation, or online at Vested.org.
LIQUIDITY	Notes should be viewed as an investment to be held to maturity, but Calvert Foundation may allow early redemption and partial withdrawals.

SECURITY AND INVESTOR PROTECTIONS


